A discussion ensued on using Lou Malnati's Pizza Coupons again for another fundraiser, having an Eat n Earn at Panera's in February and opening up the spirit wear store for a drive before Spring Break.

By Law Review - The committee met and made updates to the Proposed 2020-2022 Bylaws. Dulce read the few changes that were made from the 2018-2020 Bylaws. A motion was made to accept these and seconded. All voted in favor.

PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE:

The Welcome Back Panera Breakfast bought by the PTA was appreciated by the Fischer staff:

CogAt testing will be done in February as well as mid year benchmarking in reading for all students;
