BICYCLE POLICY

Children in 3rd, 4th or 5th grade are allowed to ride bicycles to school. However, they must first fill out and have on file in the office a Bicycle Permit/Contract. We request your help in impressing on your child the three stipulations involved in riding to school. Bicycle permits may be suspended if the following rules are not followed:

- 1. Bicycles must be walked on school grounds;
- 2. No riding double to or from home and school;
- 3. Bicycle rules of the road must be followed.
